THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

Note to mentors:

If your student does not come from a Lutheran background, he/she may become confused about the way we number the Ten Commandments.

Most Protestants list the Ten Commandments this way:	Lutherans list the Ten Commandments this way
1. You shall have no other gods before me.	1. You shall have no other gods before me.
2. You shall not make for yourself a carved image	
3. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.	2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.	3. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
5. Honor your father and your mother...	4. Honor your father and your mother...
6. You shall not murder.	5. You shall not murder.
7. You shall not commit adultery.	6. You shall not commit adultery.
8. You shall not steal.	7. You shall not steal.
9. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.	7. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
10. You shall not covet.	9. You shall not covet your house.

We Lutherans see the Protestant "2nd Commandment" about making "carved images" (idols) as part of the explanation for the First Commandment -- You shall have no other gods -- no idols!

Most other Protestants see the last two commandments -- (9) coveting property and (10) coveting people -- as the same commandment.

The Roman Catholic list of Ten Commandments is similar to the Lutherans, except for the last two:

- 9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife*
- 10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods*

You will find the Ten Commandments in the Bible in two places:

- Exodus 20:2-17
- Deuteronomy 5:7-21

Exodus 20 agrees with the Lutheran list. Deuteronomy 5 agrees with the Catholic list.

Remember that the numbers in front of the verses are not important. What the verses say -- that's important! It is all God's Word, no matter what numbers we attach to them.
